Vineyard

A Single vineyard wine made from a 1.0868 hectare vineyard planted in 1935 on a steep east facing slope of the ravine formed by the stream of San Ginés in Laguardia, Rioja Alavesa. We have named the vineyard "Barranco del San Ginés" referencing to the surrounding geography as the location of this vineyard. Planting density: 3906 Vines per hectare. Square planting pattern: 1,6m x 1,6m. Limestone soil. Altitude 526-546m. Massal selection. Old bush vines.

Winemaking

We selectively hand pick the old vines in this vineyard. The grapes are sorted, destemmed and fermented in a small tank for 2 weeks with a gentle pump over once a day. We try to make a true representation of this old vineyard that was planted on this slope in this village in 1935. The wine is aged in an oak barrel for two years where it is naturally stabilized and clarified with time.

Tasting note

On the nose we have plum, blackberry, bramble, blackcurrant and pomegranate. It has a medium plus palate with texture and layers of complexity. A complex nose that benefits from a short decanting prior to serving.
